CALL FORN. 10 SCHOLARSHIPS RESERVED FOR HOLDERS OF A FOREIGN UNIVERSITY DEGREE THAT INTEND TO ENROLL IN ADVANCED DEGREE COURSES AT THE DEPARTMENT OF POLITICAL SCIENCE A.Y. 2021/ 2022

By resolution of the Political Science Department Board of March, 31th, 2021, and in accordance with the directions of the Steering Committee of the LEPA Department Development Project, 10 scholarships are available to students that intend to enroll in the first year of the Advanced Courses of the Department of Political Science for the academic year 2021/2022.

ART. 1- Number of scholarships and amount

N. 10 scholarships of EUR 1,700.00 each are announced.

ART. 2 - Eligibility for scholarships

The selection for scholarships is open to students that intend to enroll in the first year of the following Advanced Degree Courses (Corsi di Laurea magistrale) of the Department of Political Science of the University of Perugia, in the 2021/2022 academic year:

- International relations (Relazioni internazionali)
- Politics, administration, territory (Politica, amministrazione, territorio)
- Public, digital and corporate communication (Comunicazione pubblica, digitale e d'impresa)
- Social Policies and Social Work (Politiche e servizi sociali).

In order to participate, applicants must have completed a Bachelor's Degree obtained in a foreign country that allows enrollment in the chosen master's degree program.

The Master's programs can be consulted on the website: www.scipol.unipg.it

Teaching language is Italian for all degrees (for enrollment, consult on www.unipg.it the conditions established by the University of Perugia on the knowledge of the Italian language.), except the Curriculum in *Migration, globalisation and world governance* of the master's degree program International relations whose teaching language is English (it is recommended a level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages).

ART. 3 - Scholarship conditions

The scholarship will be paid in two equal instalments: the first one will be paid by March, **31**th, 202**2**, as long as the student has obtained at least 24 credits. The second one – as well as the first one if the student fails to obtain the required credits by the first deadline – will be paid by September 30th, 202**2**, as long as the student has obtained at least a total of 50 credits, in the Master's degree Course. The first instalment, if paid, will not be claimed back.

ART. 4 - Deadlines and application procedures

The application must be drawn up on ordinary paper according to "form A", here attached and addressed to the Director of the Department of Political Science – University of Perugia. It must be received before 1 pm, on **June**, 4th 2021, under penalty of exclusion from the selection procedure.

Applications received after the deadline, although sent by post, will not be taken into account.

Applications may be submitted: by hand delivery to the Direction of the Department of Political Science, by e-mail to dipartimento.scipol@unipg.it (in this case, confirmation of receipt by the Direction is required), or by regular mail to: Via Pascoli, 20 - 06123 Perugia.

In order to comply with the deadline, the arrival stamp of the Direction of the Department of Political Science will serve as proof.

Application must include the following documents (photocopies are accepted):

- Foreign university degree, supplied with official translation in Italian language, legalization (except exemption from this requirement according to international agreements and conventions) and "dichiarazione di valore in loco" (local Declaration of Value) by the Diplomatic/Consular representation that is competent for the territory or a comparability certificate issued by ENIC-NARIC centers;
- Certificate in its original granted by the competent University attesting the passed exams, with the relative
 credits (if available) and grades translated in Italian language and duly confirmed by the Italian Delegation of
 the Embassy or Consulate that has territorial competence;
- Motivation letter of maximum 2,000 characters, written in one of the following languages: Italian, English, or French;
- Residence permit or visa typed D, where necessary;
- Identity document-

ART. 5 - Selection board and final ranking

The Selection Board is appointed by the Director of the Department of Political Science, and it is formed by at least three professors of the Department.

The Board will evaluate:

- the curriculum studiorum;
- the motivation letter.

The Commission's work will be announced on the Department's website.

At the end of the selection procedure, the final ranking will be published on the Department's website, in the "Avvisi e notizie" section, by **June 25th, 2021.**

The judgment of the Commission is unquestionable.

ART. 6 - Scholarship method of payment

The scholarship will be paid in two instalments, after the verification referred to in art. 3 of the present call.

ART. 7 - Verifying the accuracy of declarations

The Department will verify the accuracy of candidates' declarations, by making the necessary checks, and with the help of the competent authorities.
